- For GCSE and A Level Classes, our school follows the respective Edexcel Syllabus for Greek Language.
- In addition to teaching the Modern Greek Language, the school Curriculum includes Religious studies, History & Geography of Greece and Cyprus.
- Music and Traditional dance are taught by specialist teachers – thus preserving our Greek origin and culture.
- Homework is assigned by Teachers at every lesson and is compulsory for every pupil.
- Assessments are carried out frequently by teachers to assess children's progress. An annual vocabulary test is also set for each year group by the Head Teacher to assess progress.
- Textbooks and writing books are provided by the school free of charge.
